The biggest changes Kathy has seen over 40 years involve technology and government regulations. As proven in the photo below (circa 1983), even the size of computers has changed dramatically! Back in 1980 there was no Direct Deposit, ATMs or online services so everyone had to come to the credit union to deposit and withdraw. Paydays and Social Security day were very, very busy (especially if they fell on a Friday) with lines at 5 lobby tellers stretching from the window to across the lobby. There was no voice mail or email so messages were always handwritten. There were no PCs so everything was typed by hand.

Government regulations have also changed dramatically in the last 40 years so the majority of Kathy's time is now spent ensuring the credit union complies with new regulatory requirements, keeping updated on regulatory changes, writing policies and procedures and training staff on what they need to do to comply.

Kathy says the best thing about having worked at CCU for 40 years is that she's gotten to know so many wonderful members. She enjoys running into them outside the credit union and chatting about what's happening in their life. We really are part of a big Cloverbelt Credit Union family.
