Don't Fall for This Text or Email Scam "Your package delivery is delayed."

With the prevalence of online ordering, package delivery scam texts and emails are increasing, especially around the holidays. Scammers know the chance of someone expecting a package delivery is high and they count on you being anxious thinking it's delayed. The messages may be vague or appear to be from UPS, FedEx, or the USPS and state they're having problems delivering your package, including a link for you to provide delivery instructions. The link actually takes you to a bogus website that prompts you to input personal or credit card information that is then used to steal your identity or scam you. The link may also install malware on your phone or computer giving the scammer access to your device. Most online companies provide a package tracking number for your order so you can check the delivery status online. Remember: Only use the legitimate website for UPS, FedEx, or the USPS to track your package and NEVER CLICK ON A TEXT or EMAIL LINK from an UNKNOWN SENDER.
