Cloverbelt Credit Union will award \$1,000 scholarships to selected graduating high school seniors who are members of the credit union and who are planning to attend a 4-year university or a 2-year technical or trade school.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a member of Cloverbelt Credit Union for a minimum of six months and in good standing. A member in good standing is defined as one with a minimum account balance of \$5 and no loan delinquencies.
- Be a graduating high school senior who is continuing their education at a post-secondary university, technical or trade school.
