Fraud Alert

Here's another scam members frequently contact us about. You'll receive a call claiming to be from a fraud alert center regarding your debit or credit card. They lead you to believe the call is legitimate by using generic wording such as "we're calling from Mastercard about a suspicious transaction" or something similar. During the conversation, the scammer asks for your card number, expiration date and security code as a way to verify your identity. With that, they have all the information they need to make purchases with your card. With enough information from you, they may be able to make changes to the account that suppress normal fraud monitoring, such as increasing credit limits, changing the PIN and adding travel exemptions.

Fraud alerts for your CCU debit card can be by phone, text or email. A legitimate fraud alert process DOES NOT include providing the security code on your card, your full social security number, your PIN or a one-time passcode that's sent to your phone.
