## Go Paperless for a chance to WIN \$100

Keep your account information safe, save a tree, and be entered into a drawing for \$100. Use the CU-Online home banking site or our mobile banking app to monitor your account activity and view, download or print your statements.

Users who log into online banking in July and agree to STOP paper statements will be entered into a drawing to win \$100. Just tap any account, select "Documents", then accept the E-SIGN disclosure to automatically stop paper statements.

New users can select the "Enroll" link at the top of our website or download the Cloverbelt CU Mobile Banking app from their favorite app store and enroll. If you need help, call us at 715-842-5693 or visit any CCU office.

## Reunite with Your Money!!

All states require businesses and financial institutions to report unclaimed and abandoned property to the state treasurer after a specified period of time, typically 3 to 5 years. This could be a savings, checking or IRA account with no activity, checks that were never cashed, safe deposit boxes with unpaid rent, life insurance policies where beneficiaries can't be located, and more.

It's easy to check if you have unclaimed property waiting to be reunited with you, and it's **FREE** to search for and receive your money.

- Search Wisconsin's database at https://tap.revenue.wi.gov/ UCPSearch/\_/#4 or by searching online for "Wisconsin unclaimed property"
- Search all states at missingmoney.com
- Search for unclaimed Wisconsin child support payments at https://www.revenue.wi.gov/Pages/UnclaimedProperty/ child-support.aspx or by searching online for "Wisconsin unclaimed child support"

If you find unclaimed funds or property in your name, follow the instructions on the website for how to file a claim and what documentation is required to verify your identity.

Remember, you do not need to pay a third-party to claim your property, even if they contact you directly to let you know there is an unclaimed property listing in your name.
