Joan E., Brian T., and Larry W. were each \$100 winners in the statewide drawing.



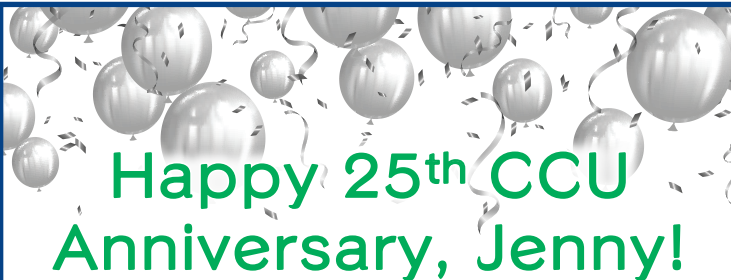
